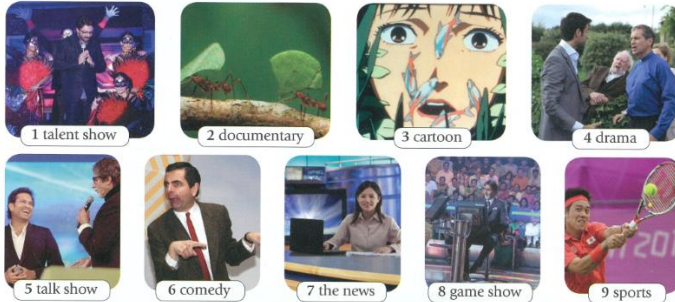

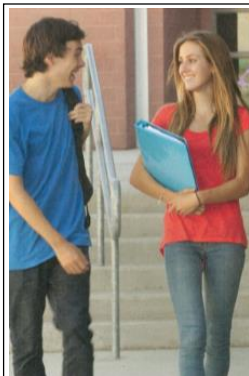
Simple past

He went out last night.	She didn't go out.	Did they go out last night? Yes, they did. / No, they didn't.
