He was **so** tired **that** he fell asleep at this desk.

He had **so** many qualifications **that** he could choose any job.

He spent **so** much time in the office **that** his wife complained.

Such + noun that...たいそうに...で...だった。)

She was **such** a hard worker **that** she got promoted.

She earned **such** a lot of money **that** she didn't know how to spend it.

2. Not as ~ + as ~ (~ほど~でない。)

My work day isn't as long + **as** yours.
→My work day is shorter than yours.

Nurses don't **earn as much** + **as** doctors.
→Nurses earn less than doctors.

My work day isn't **as long** + **as** yours
