Our five senses let us explore the world around us. The five senses are sight, hearing, touch, smell, and taste. The senses work with the brain to help us learn new things and enjoy the world.



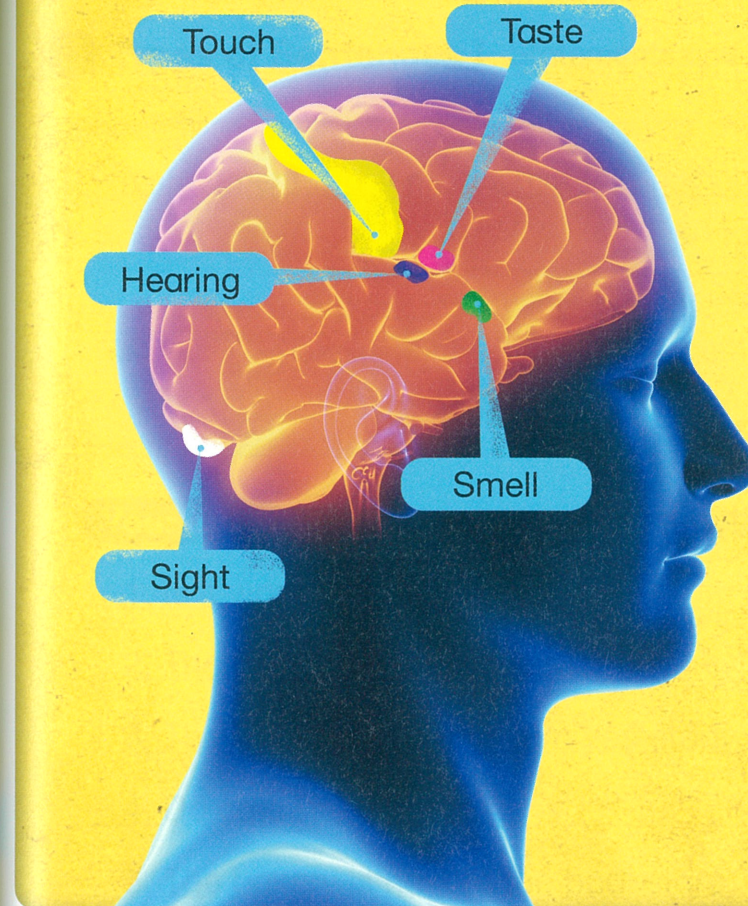

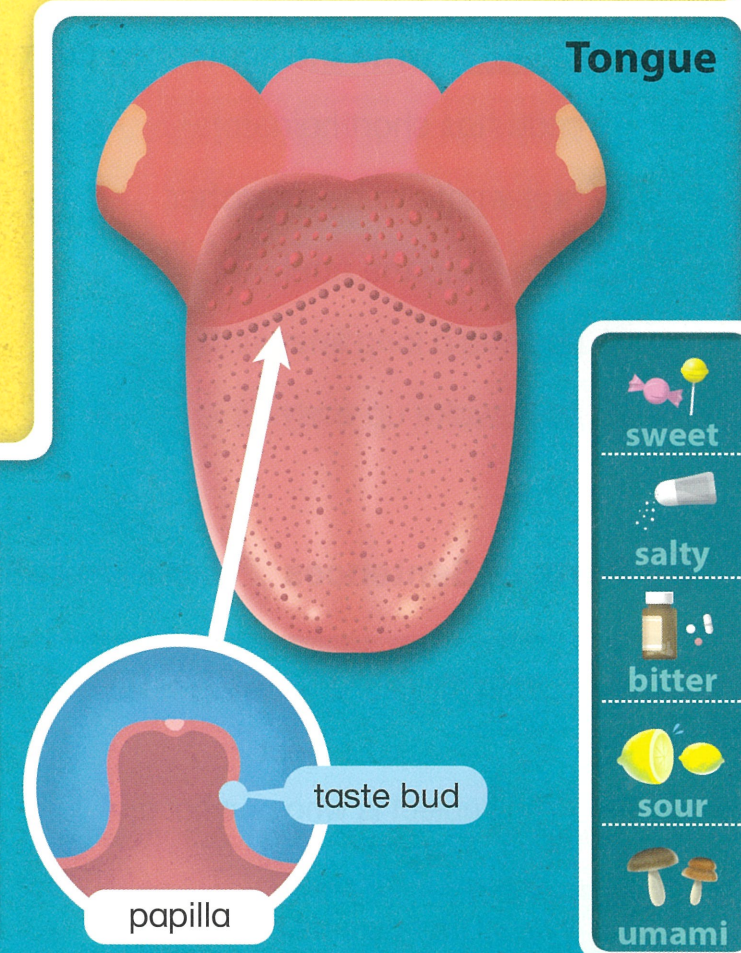


Fact 1

Different parts of the brain have different jobs. So, if those specific parts of the brain get damaged, we may not see, hear, feel, smell, or taste properly.

Fact 2

The taste buds on our tongue let us taste different flavors. A taste bud is located on a small bump called a papilla. The taste buds can sense five different flavors: sweet, salty, bitter, sour, and umami.
