It's <b>going to</b> rain.  <small>(あの黒い雲を見て。雨が降るね)</small></p>	<p>What are you <b>going to do</b>?</p> <p>I'm not sure. I <b>guess</b> I'll just <b>stay</b> home.</p> <p><b>Maybe</b> I'll <b>take</b> a course.</p> <p>I don't know. I <b>think</b> I'll <b>go</b> camping.</p> <p>I <b>probably won't go</b> anywhere.</p>

probably...	I think so, yet I'm not 100% sure.

<p>You <b>must</b> have health insurance.  <small>(～しなければならない)</small></p> <p>You <b>need to be</b> 21 or over.  <small>(必要がある)</small></p> <p>You <b>have to</b> get a passport.  <small>(～しなければならない)</small></p> <p>You <b>don't have to</b> get vaccinations.  <small>(～しなくてもいい)</small></p>	<p>You'd <b>better</b> avoid the stalls on the street.  <small>(～すべき)</small></p> <p>You <b>ought to</b> make a copy of your passport.  <small>(～すべき)</small></p> <p>You <b>should</b> try some local specialties.  <small>(～するほうがいい)</small></p> <p>You <b>shouldn't</b> carry a lot of cash.  <small>(～すべきではない)</small></p>
