Modal+ simple form of verb 「~してくれませんか」	 Point! Would you mind...ing? 「~してくれませんか」 "please"がついてなくても丁寧に聞こえる
Can you keep your cat inside, <u>please</u> ? Could you turn the music down , <u>please</u> ? Would you <u>please</u> park your car in your space?	Would you mind keeping your cat inside? Would you mind turning the music down , please? Would you mind not parking your car in my space?
